








Meet the extraordinary artist who has created insightful works of art despite being diagnosed with Asperger's Syndrome, a form of autism. Despite the challenges posed by this disorder, 20-year-old Delwin Cheah Wien Loong continues to astound his family, friends, and a growing number of admirers. Individuals with Asperger's Syndrome often struggle with social interactions and exhibit rigid and repetitive behavior and thought patterns. However, this has not hindered the Penang-born artist from honing his skills and pursuing his passion for art.

A dreamer at heart, Delwin enjoys sharing his story of resilience and his incredible journey, which began at the tender age of three. By the time he was nine, one of his masterpieces was showcased at the United Nations building in New York as part of the Strokes of Genius Art Exhibition, held in conjunction with World Autism Awareness. Since then, Delwin has held numerous exhibitions, earning him the world record for being the "World's Youngest Savant Artist to Hold Solo Art Exhibition," as recognized by Record Setter, USA. He also holds the titles of "Malaysia's Youngest Artist to Hold a Solo Visual Art Exhibition" and "Malaysia's Most Outstanding Personality in the Art Category" in the Malaysia Book of Records for 2014. Delwin's artwork has been presented to world leaders, and he has received letters of appreciation from President Barack Obama of the United States and Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II of England.

From a young age, Cheah developed a deep love for nature and an awareness of the plight of endangered animals. With his unwavering commitment to wildlife conservation, Delwin collaborated with the Worldwide Fund Malaysia (WWF) to design a limited edition "Malayan Tiger" t-shirt, with the proceeds going towards the largest wildlife conservation organization in the world. Recognizing his contributions, the Malaysian government named him the new icon of Malaysia, or "Ikon Negaraku," at one of its national unity platforms. Alongside his family, he established the HUKU Tigers Awareness movement to raise awareness about the Malayan Tigers among schools and communities.

For Delwin, the purpose of his art lies in capturing the world's beauty. He strives to differentiate himself from other artists by perceiving things differently and daring to paint with his emotions rather than simply learning about them. He expresses, I believe the world is incredibly beautiful, and I want to share this with everyone through my drawings and paintings.
